## Principal Update - Tim Mankin

- Pleased with how ISTEP has gone. Testing is completed for now, but will pick up again mid-April with the online multiple choice.
- Playgound
  - HSE District will give \$0 towards a playground at HIJH; they are giving Riverside \$5K, which doesn't cover much.
  - Mr. Mankin has shut down the idea of asking the PTO to donate funds as this is not SOP in the district and would be an unfair burden to place upon our parents.
  - Mr. Mankin agrees there are limited options for students who don't care for team sport activities and stated that swings and/or a horizontal climbing wall would be good ideas if funds were available.
- Panther Fest: On-site contacts will be Jeff lagulli and Chad Guest.
- HSSF Game Day: HIJH are the WINNERS for most money donated to the cause WOO HOO!
- Already planning for end-of-year awards and such.
- 7<sup>th</sup> Grade class selections for next year is on hold until course offerings are solidified. Options will be presented to the Board on 3/8/17.
- 6<sup>th</sup> graders going into 7<sup>th</sup> grade: Course selections are completed.
- Neighborhood Rebalance:

#### Panther Rewards (Marabeth Pereira):

- Kroger Rewards: The next payout will be after the end of March.

#### Panther Fest (Tim Baldwin):

- Pepsi products have been purchased; waiting for Coke products to go on sale.
- Candy will be purchased through Chad.
- Security for the evening has not yet been set.
- There will be daily announcements the week of Panther Fest, leading up to Friday.
- Registration forms went home Wednesday and will be posted to the PTO website (update: they have been posted to the website and on the HIJH Facebook page).
- Tattoo machine needs to be fixed and a location needs to be finalized for tattoos.
- There will be a selfie station as well.
- Volunteers will be given wrist bands that differ in color from the students (there are some leftover from Palooza).
- Concessions will be in Panther Hall rather than the Concession stand due to number of anticipated attendees.

#### Treasury Report (Paul Count):

- Currently we have \$8,700 cash position this year over this time last year.

#### New Topics:

- o Teacher Grants:
  - Per Mr. Mankin, teachers were recently given \$70 each to spend through the district.
  - When supplies are needed, staff can request them through departmental and/or principal instructional funds.
  - If the PTO is looking to make a donation, Mr. Mankin suggested perhaps supplies for the soon-to-be Maker Space might be a good place to consider.
  - HIJH is installing visual bulletin boards (flat screen TVs) and already have three of the four they need.
  - Mr. Mankin suggested any teacher requests be submitted in spring/early summer with award/fulfillment in the fall.
  - Per Paul Count, we will have a better idea of available funds once Panther Fest and Q1 Kroger Rewards numbers are in. Paul suggests waiting until then to determine what we can allocate.
    - Paul will work on a form for teachers to fill out, which will include a
      deadline of Friday, September 1<sup>st</sup>.
