School Update - Mr. Mankin

- eLearning
 - o There is limit on eLearning days during the year, but can only have three consecutive days.
- GAC
 - Due to a copyright issue, GAC was renamed to CSS (Comprehensive Student Success)
 - There will be socioemotional health curriculum for K-12
- Redistricting
 - FCJH held the annual transition meeting for sixth graders from FCI. This meeting was not for students that will be redistricted. That meeting will be on a different date.
 - HJH currently has 71 students that are choosing to grandfather. There are 20 students that were redistricted to HJH from other schools. That puts HJH at 1101 students for 2019-20 school year.
