- last year total was 525 planners purchased. PTO sold 351 (pre orders sold for \$8, at Panther Preview \$10), 55 to ENL (\$5 each), donated 119 to SPED.
- $\quad * *$ We sold planners at above costs to help cover the cost of the donated planners.
- this year we pre-ordered 600 for the 22-23 school year@3.56/planner. 200 for SPED, 50 to ENL and 350 for the PTO to sell. (We get a larger discount when all ordered at one time and early. Last year we had to order additional and they cost us significantly more; trying to avoid that this year).
- Hope is to break even
- School Kits
- Sale is open till May 19th
- We qualify for the extra $1 \%$.
- We have to sell $\$ 10 \mathrm{k}$ worth of kits to qualify for free shipping.
